The heart behind Steadfast & Sustained started before college, during a season at the end of high school when I felt unsure about what was ahead.

I began writing down Scripture, sermon notes, prayers, and reminders of God's promises so I had something tangible to return to when I felt anxious or uncertain.

Over time, those pages became more than notes. They became reminders of God's faithfulness, and they helped me grow in peace and trust that He was with me — even when I could not see the whole path ahead.

One day while journaling, I had the thought: *I would love to create a journal that helps other people grow closer to God, too.* A couple of years later, before my first semester of college began, I started designing that first journal.

Once college started, Steadfast & Sustained quickly became part of my everyday life. I packaged orders on my dorm-room desk or on the floor, designed new products between classes, filmed content in whatever free moments I had, and learned how to grow a business while studying Marketing and minoring in Ministry.

What started as one journal has now grown into a community of more than 35,000 people around the world. And so much of that growth has happened because one person found something that helped them, then shared it with someone else.

That is what you get to be part of here. And now you get to help carry that story forward in your own voice, with your own community, in a way only you can.

When you share Steadfast & Sustained, you are not just sharing a journal. You are helping someone find a simple place to slow down, remember God's truth, reflect on what He is teaching them, and make intentional space for Him in whatever season they are in.

Our mission. To encourage and equip believers to grow closer to God by creating guided journals and faith-based tools that help them engage with Scripture, remember His truth, reflect on His faithfulness, and build intentional rhythms with Him in every season.

Your first five steps

If you do nothing else in this kit, start here. These five things will make it easy for someone who connects with what you share to actually find the product.

1 Put your link somewhere easy to find.

Add it to your bio and use a link sticker when you share Steadfast on Stories. If someone loves what you posted, make the next step simple.

2 Capture your first impression, then share again after you have actually used it.

An unboxing or first-look video can be fun, and some of the most meaningful content happens once the journal has your handwriting, your notes, and your real life inside it. Those two moments tell different parts of the story.

3 Show the journal open.

Let people see how you actually use it. Sunday sermon notes, Bible study, a planner page, your desk on a Tuesday morning. Real use helps someone picture it in their own life.

4 Share your link and your code.

Say your code out loud, put it on screen, and keep your link easy to tap. Some in-app browsers can interfere with link tracking, so using both also helps make sure your sales are attributed correctly.

5 Give one clear next step.

“It’s linked in my bio.” “Use my code for 10% off.” “Tap the link in my Story.”

That’s it! Start with what feels natural, show the journal in your real life, and let your own experience lead the way.



Check in on your creator dashboard once a week. You can see clicks, orders and commission, and learn which kinds of content your community is connecting with most.

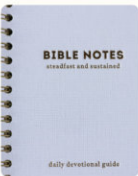

A tip about sharing the products: Steadfast & Sustained is about more than beautiful stationery. Our products are tools that help people grow closer to God, remember His truth, and build intentional rhythms with Him in the middle of everyday life. It helps to share how the journaling format has transformed your church notes, devotional or planning time vs. only showing the cover!

Content that tends to connect

Start with the reason someone should care.

Instead of opening with “Hi guys,” begin with the problem, the moment, or the result.

Show it in real life.

Filled pages, real handwriting, your Bible open beside it, the journal actually coming to church with you. It does not need to look perfect.

Tell your reason.

Why did you start writing things down? What have you been able to remember or return to because of it? Your personal experience is what resonates with your audience & helps them connect to seeing the product benefits in their life as well!

You do not need a huge audience.

Some of our most meaningful creator partnerships come from smaller communities where people genuinely trust the person they are following.

Let it show up naturally over time.

You do not have to create one giant polished campaign. Share the journal when it actually fits your life: Sunday, Bible study, a planning morning, or a moment when you look back at an old page.

The goal is not to make the perfect content, although we love seeing & sharing aesthetic content! It's to help someone watching think, “Wait, that would actually help me too.”

12 easy content ideas to make your own!

My last month of sermon notes. Turn through filled pages. Read one line that stuck with you.

Sunday morning, real time. Coffee, Bible, journal, pen. Barely narrated.

Why I started writing it down. The season when you couldn't remember anything God was teaching you.

How I actually take church notes. Walk people through what works for you.

Scattered notes app to one journal. Show what felt scattered before, then what changed.

Opening a new color. The paper, the gold foil, the size in your hand.

Three things I write every Sunday. Fast cuts, one per section. Easy to repeat monthly.

What I'm giving every Christian in my life. Strong October through December.

My Sunday-to-Sunday rhythm. Church Notes on Sunday, Bible Notes and planner midweek.

What I'd tell a friend about it. Honesty builds trust.

Desk reset with my journals. Slow, satisfying, text on screen.

Read the verse you wrote this week. Builds trust for everything else.



STORY INSPIRATION

Ten Stories that take under a minute

Stories are especially helpful because someone can go directly from seeing how you use the journal to tapping your link sticker — and they can stay very simple.

- This morning's page with your link sticker.
- A poll: spiral or hardcover.
- An "ask me anything about journaling" box.
- Which color next.
- Journal on the passenger seat on the way to church.
- A reshare of your own post with "a few of you asked, here's the link."
- What you're underlining today.
- Your code on its own slide in big text, because people screenshot those.
- A page from three months ago.
- A countdown when we tell you something is coming.

Four captions, ready to fill in

Use these exactly as written, tweak them to sound like you, or tell your own story! Your audience follows you for your voice, not ours.

The short one: Still one of my favorite things I bring to church every Sunday. I love having one place to keep what I am learning instead of losing it in random pages. It's linked in my bio, and YOURCODE saves you 10% 

The personal one: I started writing sermon notes down because I kept forgetting what I had heard by the middle of the week. Now I can flip back through months of messages and remember what God was teaching me in completely different seasons. If you have been wanting a place to keep yours too, it's linked in my bio. YOURCODE saves you 10%.

The teaching one: How I take church notes — key points at the top, the scripture, then the reflection questions at the end so the message carries into my week. Journal linked in my bio, YOURCODE for 10% off.

The gift one: If you're stuck on what to get the person in your life who loves Jesus — this, every time. Linked in my bio, YOURCODE saves you 10%.

The short list

Show the journal open with your real handwriting in it. Put your link in your bio and on a Stories link sticker. Make your link or code easy to find. Tag us so we can reshare you, and send the original file at full resolution if you'd like to be featured. And always feel free to reach out & share what is working & changes you'd like to see with the products or affiliate program, if any!

GETTING PAID

Commission is earned on completed orders attributed through your personal link or creator code. Cancelled, returned or refunded orders are not commissionable, and your own purchases do not count toward creator milestones. Shopify Collabs handles payouts according to the payout schedule shown in your dashboard. We recommend sharing both your link and your code — some in-app browsers can affect link tracking, so your code gives us another way to make sure your referral is credited to you.

MORE WAYS TO EARN

Our journals are also sold on Amazon, Walmart and TikTok Shop! If you already create there, join the creator program for each and share our stores too. **You earn 10% commission on Amazon and TikTok Shop**, the same rate as your Steadfast link and code, and Walmart pays through Walmart Creator. The TikTok Shop affiliate program is joined in the app, under Creator Tools.

Other helpful details

Do I have to show my face? Not at all. Holding a journal, text on screen, or a voiceover can all work beautifully. If you are comfortable showing your face, it can help your audience connect the product with a real person and a real experience. The most important thing is that people can clearly see the journal, understand how you use it, and hear why it matters to you.

How often should I post? There is no need to force content just to hit a number. We recommend aiming for about one Steadfast-related post per week when it naturally fits your content — but the more the better! — plus Stories whenever you are using the product or want to share more quickly! Think real life over campaign mode: bringing your journal to church, a Bible study morning, a page you want to remember, planning your week, or wearing one of our faith-based pieces out for coffee. Consistency helps, but authenticity matters more.

Who do I ask when I am stuck? Reply to any email from us, or DM us on Instagram! A real person reads every single one, and we would so much rather hear from you than not.
